## Client Gear Checklist: Guided Fly Fishing Day Trips

Heading out with Immersive Angling? Here's what to pack to get the most out of your guided Dullstroom fly fishing experience.

---

### Essential Gear (Bring Your Own or Let Us Know if You Need to Borrow)

- **Fly Rod** – 10ft - #3 to #5 weight soft action recommended
  - **Reel** – With working drag system and matched to your rod
  - **Floating Fly Line** – In good condition
  - **Leader & Tippet** – 9ft 3X tapered leader. Tippet 4x to 6X mono. Fluorocarbon for droppers
  - **Fly Box** – Your favourite dry flies, nymphs & buzzer patterns (we'll also bring backup patterns)
  - **Forceps or Pliers** – For hook removal and pinching barbs – BARBLESS HOOKS ONLY
  - **Floatant** – For keeping dry flies high and visible

### Recommended Clothing

- **Hat or Cap** – For sun protection and visibility
  - **Polarized Sunglasses** – Essential for spotting fish and protecting eyes
  - **Quick-Dry Layers** – Light fleece or wicking shirts work best
  - **Rain Jacket** – Weather in the Highlands can change quickly
  - **Warm Socks** – Even in summer, morning temps can be chilly

### Clothing

- **Wading Boots or Sturdy Shoes** – No flip-flops or slip-ons please
- **Pants / Shorts and shirts** – Lightweight – UV resistant
- **Warm jacket** for mornings and nippy days
